

The main purpose of the program is to contribute to the development and strengthening of the nursing profession in our country.

The budget allocated for the program is 120000 TL.

It has been funded 73 projects in total since 2021. In 2022, it has been decided to support 3 projects.





Project Acceptance Criteria:

- Be original,
- Have the ability to contribute to science, technology, economy, cultural and social life when it ends,
- Have ability to transfer the results to nursing practices, to make changes / initiate a new application, to improve patient care outcomes,
- Be the basis for the production of new projects,





- Contribute to the improvement of nursing education, management and practices,
- Able to prove the effect of nursing care,
- Reflect the collaboration of nurses working in the academic and practical fields,
- Be planned to be made with an interdisciplinary team preferably in Turkey,
- Research projects in the clinic and / or in the field, carried out with quantitative, qualitative or mixed methods are supported.





Researches That Will Not Be Evaluated:

- Descriptive studies with small samples,
- Scale adaptation studies,
- Basic science researches in the laboratory,
- Documentaries about history of nursing profession etc. and / or oral history studies about people who have provided important services in this field,
- Secondary researches such as systematic compilation and meta-analysis will not be evaluated.
